# AFTERSCHOOL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## How do I register for Y Afterschool?

To register for Y Afterschool, you can stop by and sign up in person at any one of your local YMCA of Greater Williamson County branch locations: Cedar Park (Twin Lakes Family YMCA), Hutto (Hutto Family YMCA), Round Rock (Y Licensed Child Care Offices) or Georgetown (3010 Williams Dr. Suite 210) or sign up online at ([ymcagwc.org](http://ymcagwc.org)).

## Where can I pick up a Y Afterschool registration packet?

Y Afterschool registration packets can be printed from our website ([ymcagwc.org](http://ymcagwc.org)) or picked up at any one of our branch locations listed above.

## May I register for Y Afterschool at a YMCA of Austin location?

No. All registrations for Y Afterschool at school sites in Williamson County must be done at any one of your local YMCA of Greater Williamson County branch locations listed above.

## On what days and during which hours does the Y Afterschool program run?

Y Afterschool runs weekdays (Monday–Friday) from school dismissal until 6:30 p.m.

## How much does Y Afterschool cost?

A complete chart of monthly rates for our Y Afterschool program can be found online ([ymcagwc.org](http://ymcagwc.org)) or among the information included as part of your registration packet.

## Is there a registration fee for Y Afterschool?

Yes. A nonrefundable and nontransferable registration fee of \$50.00 is required per child for processing and curriculum materials each year. Of note, if you withdraw from the program and wish to return later, you will be required to pay the registration fee a second time.

## Is there a discount when registering multiple children in Y Afterschool?

No. Each child's tuition for Y Afterschool is the same.

## What discounts for Y Afterschool are offered?

Family members of the YMCA of Greater Williamson County and full-time school district employees receive discounted tuition. Of note, school district employees must work at a school district in which the YMCA of Greater Williamson County provides after school care.

## When are payments for Y Afterschool due?

Payment for Y Afterschool are due on the first (1st) of each month from August – May.

## How may I pay my Y Afterschool tuition?

You may pay your Y Afterschool tuition in each of the following ways:

- Paying online at our website [ymcagwc.org](http://ymcagwc.org)
  - In person with cash, check, money order or credit card at your local YMCA of Greater Williamson County branch location.
  - Through the mail with a check or money order (YMCA of Greater Williamson County, P.O. Box 819, Round Rock, TX 78680).
  - By setting up an automatic draft from a checking account or credit card (see the Bank Draft form in your registration packet).
- Of note, payments are allowed not allowed by phone or at any Y Afterschool school sites.

## Does the Y offer financial assistance?

Yes. Information and applications for financial assistance are available online ([ymcagwc.org](http://ymcagwc.org)) or at any one of your local YMCA of Greater Williamson County branch locations listed above.

## Where is the Y Afterschool program held?

Students in our Y Afterschool program will remain on-site at their elementary school during program hours. Our program utilizes the cafeteria, gym and playground areas.

## What does a typical Y Afterschool day look like?

Students in our Y Afterschool program will first gather in the cafeteria. They will then be provided with a daily snack as well as water. From there, students will move through a rotation of games, art, gym time and playground activities.

## Will my child receive help with their homework while in the Y Afterschool program?

A quiet time is provided each day during Y Afterschool where students may work on their homework. Unfortunately, due to the size of our program, Y Counselors are not able to work individually with each student on their homework.

## How are students grouped during Y Afterschool?

Y Afterschool students are typically grouped with other children that are in their same grade or either a grade above or below them. The exception to this rule is at some of our smaller school sites where the whole group moves between activities together.

## Is Y Afterschool a licensed program?

Yes. Our Y Afterschool program is licensed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services.

# YMCA AFTERSCHOOL ENRICHMENTS

The Georgetown Family YMCA offers curriculum based enrichment programs to boost their Afterschool learning. These programs are sessions that include 6 classes with a trained instructor in each specialized field.

Enrichments must be paid for by the 1st of each month. Registration will not be taken after the 1st so there is time to prepare the amount of materials needed.
